

Ⅲ. 環境の保全・創造のための施策

1. 施策の基本方針と体系

この計画は、「沖縄県環境基本条例」の基本理念に基づき、『豊かな自然環境に恵まれたやすらぎと潤いのある沖縄県』一ト(2001年度実施)等による県民の望む環境像を踏まえた様々このため、本県の環境問題について長期的な視野に立ったかにかにするとともに、その方向に沿った各種環境保全施策を展開する共通的・基盤的な施策も合わせて推進するとともに、本県し、重点的・効果的な推進を図ります。

環境への付加の少ない循環型の社会づくり

生産、流通、消費、廃棄等の社会経済活動の全段階を通じて、資源やエネルギーの効率的・循環的な利用を進め、汚染物質や廃棄物の発生抑制、適正処理を図ることなどにより、自然の物質循環に与える影響を極力抑えた『環境への負荷の少ない循環型の社会づくり』に向けた環境保全施策として、「大気環境の保全」、「水環境の保全」、「化学物質対策の推進」、「騒音・振動・悪臭の防止」、「土壌・地下水環境の保全」、「赤土等流出の防止」、「廃棄物・リサイクル対策の推進」を推進します。




環境保全活動への積極的な参加

県民、事業者、行政等のすべての主体が、それぞれの立場に応じた公平な役割分担のもと、『環境保全活動への積極的な参加』に向けた環境保全施策として、「環境教育・環境学習の推進」、「自主的な環境保全活動の促進」、「普及・啓発活動の推進」を推進します。



人と自然が共生する潤いのある地域づくり

優れた自然環境や多様な生態系を保全し、様々な自然とのふれあいの場や機会を確保するなどの『人と自然が共生する潤いのある地域づくり』に向けた環境保全施策として、「緑・水辺・景観の保全と創造」、「歴史・文化環境の保全と創造」、「海域生態系の保全」、「陸域生態系の保全」、「陸水域生態系の保全」を推進します。



地球環境の保全に貢献する社会づくり

地球環境問題の解決に向け、地域からの取り組みを着実に実施することや、環境保全に関する地域からの国際協力に努めるなど『地球環境の保全に貢献する社会づくり』に向けた環境保全施策として、「地球温暖化防止対策の推進」、「オゾン層保護対策の推進」、「酸性雨対策の推進」、「その他の地球環境問題への取組の推進」、「国際環境協力の推進」を推進します。



III. Measures for Environmental Conservation and Creation

1. Basic Policies and Structure

In accordance with the primary principles of the Okinawa to help provide A Peaceful Okinawa Blessed with an Abundant future generations. Various measures and actions will be set out based Plan, as well as the results of a questionnaire (conducted in FY 2001) To this end, the following four goals have been established based on Plan defines the basic direction and specific environmental measures required to achieve these goals. The conservation measures to be taken in each area, as well as the basic environmental conservation will also be established based on implementation.

Creation of a recycling-type society that has less impact on the environment

Creating a recycling society with less impact on the environment requires minimizing the impacts on the natural material cycle. This can be achieved by promoting efficient use and recycling of resource and energy at all stages of social and economic activities, including production, distribution, consumption, and disposal, as well as reducing pollutants and wastes, and promoting proper treatment. The environmental conservation measures towards these ends include: Conservation of the atmospheric environment; Conservation of the aquatic environment; Promotion of measures against chemical substances; Prevention of noise, vibrations, and offensive odor; Conservation of soil and groundwater environment; Prevention of red soil runoff; and Promotion of waste and recycling measures.



Active participation in environmental preservation activities

Community residents, businesses, and government should take equal responsibility in taking proactive efforts to preserve the environment. Environmental conservation measures to achieve this include: Enhancing environmental education and learning; Promoting voluntary environmental conservation activities; and Publicity efforts and promoting public awareness.



Developing a rich community where people and nature coexist together

Developing a rich community where people and nature coexist together involves preserving nature and diverse ecosystems, and creating space and opportunities to enjoy nature in various forms. The environmental conservation measures towards these ends include: Preservation and creation of greenery, waterside areas, and scenic sites; Preservation and creation of historic and cultural sites; Conservation of marine ecosystems; Conservation of terrestrial ecosystems; and Conservation of freshwater ecosystems



Fostering a society that contributes to global environmental conservation

Fostering a society that contributes to global environmental conservation involves taking local action towards resolving global environmental problems, and international cooperation for environmental conservation at local levels. Environmental conservation measures to achieve this goal include: Promotion of measures against global warming; Promotion of measures to preserve the ozone layer; Promotion of measures against acid rain; Efforts to resolve global environmental problems; and International cooperation for the environment.
